#### 7. DIRECTIONS

**I-87 (heading South):** Take exit 17N (merges onto Route 9 North). Take **Right** onto Route 197 at light (follow signs to Fort Edward). Take **Right** at T onto Route 4 South (at intersection in Fort Edward). Farm is approximately 4.5 miles on Left. Look for signs for Pine Meadow Farm SOUTH entrance.

**I-87 (heading North):** Take exit 14, bear **Right** back over I-87. Take **Right** onto Henning Rd (following signs for Route 29). Take **Right** onto Route 29 East. Follow into Schuylerville, intersection / light. Turn **Left** onto Route 4 North. Bear **Right** over metal bridge following Route 4 North (Take the entire bridge). We are on Route 4 North, just past Carey Rd on the **Right**. Look for signs for Pine Meadow Farm SOUTH entrance.

#### 8. FOOTING

Farm is situated on 255 acres. 2 Large (20m x 60m) Sand arenas. 2 Warm-up arenas with same footing. Additional grass warm up area available. Excellent footing (not deep) Introductory and Training Levels may be held in a small arena 20m x 40m.
